A Few Notes from the Health Room:

Please remember if your child is running a fever of 100 degrees or greater, or has had vomiting and diarrhea, keep them home for at least 24 hours after the last episode and/or they have had no fever without medicine (Tylenol/Ibuprofen).

This time of year is very hard on our skin. Our skin can become dry/cracked/chaffed and that can cause increased pain, itching, and even increase our risk of infections. Applying an ample amount of skin lotion after bathing and drinking at least a few glasses of water a day helps to keep the skin moist and hydrated. Also remember to apply lip balm or vasoline to your lips regularly to help decrease chapping and cracking of the lips.
